ONBOARDING



- Your presentation will take place over **Zoom**. Please make sure that Zoom is installed on your device beforehand.
- Arrive at the onboarding room **30 minutes** prior to the start of your talk. Please be aware of any time differences due to time zones.
- You will receive your onboarding room credentials via email approximately 3 days prior to the conference.
- Please wait in the **onboarding room** for one of our staff members. They will meet you and conduct your personal onboarding in one of the Zoom breakout rooms.
- During onboarding, we will check your **setup**, individual functionalities, and answer any final questions.
- If your presentation includes **video** or **sound**, it is important that you enable your computer's sound in addition to screen sharing.
- As the last step of your onboarding, we will send you the **final link** to your presentation room in Zoom.
- In the final Zoom room, a **moderator** will be waiting for you. They will inform you about the live start of your session, present you and your topic to the participants, and hand over the floor to you.
- Then, you may begin your presentation.



























CONFERENCE PLATFORM



- All talks will be recorded and streamed live on our online conference platform devm.io.
- devm.io is the **main platform** for networking and interacting with participants. You can follow the entire main conference here.
- devm.io and the conference website will present the program in the time zone in which the conference is held. Please keep this in mind when making plans.
- On **devmio**, (remote) participants can ask questions about your session using the public **chat**.
- Your **access** to devmio: Please enter your e-mail address and password at https:// devm.io/login. Please use the same e-mail address that you have used in our previous communication.
- Under Events & Tutorials > My Events you will see the respective conference. You are already registered there as Speaker. Search for your session in the program. The "Live Discussion" box is located to the right of your session window.
- Typically, the session moderator will conduct a brief Q&A with you at the end of the
 session to discuss/answer questions asked in the public chat. However, you are welcome to discuss a different approach with the moderator. Please allow about 5 minutes
 for the Q&A during your session time.

Tip: We recommend following the devm.io chat on a second screen. Please make sure the tab or video is muted on the second device. Note: the stream on devm.io has a slight delay of about 15 seconds.
